When a person has been accepted for membership all club grounds and activities are available for use in accordance with our Standard Operating Procedures (SOP's). (excludes grandchildren) Minors under the age of (16) must be accompanied by an adult to access club facilities. Under no circumstances shall gate keys be loaned to non-members. Up to (5) guests may be accompanied by a member to use club facilities.
