

Summary of proposed changes to bylaws:

1. Changed revision date to correspond to receipt of ballots for these changes (proposed changes to timeline for 2022 ballot receipt is May 30 for board approval)
2. ARTICLE III, ANNUAL MEMBERSHIP: Added requirement for an adult accompanying a minor under the age of 16 on club property to be a Club member. *Rational: An adult who is not a Club member may not be familiar with SOPs and could unintentionally violate club safety rules.*
3. ARTICLE IV, OFFICERS AND THEIR DUTIES: Added methods of balloting and vote collection to include USPS mail, electronic and absentees voting for election of officers and other ballot issues. *Rational: This provides a fair opportunity for all Club members to participate in election of officers.*
4. ARTICLE IV, OFFICERS AND THEIR DUTIES: Added the Vice President as signatory on club bank account. *Rational: Facilitates expediting the payment of club bills.*
5. ARTICLE V, DIRECTORS: Clarified initial wording and the number of BOD members from 16 to 17 that includes the past president. Changed the BOD quorum to include two officers and eight members, clarified BOD member removal/replacement requirements. Added free membership requirement for BOD members and range chairs. *Rational: BOD quorum should have a balance of officers and directors and free membership is reasonable compensation for voluntary time spent coordinating club business.*
6. ARTICLE VII, CLUB RULES: Clarified requirements for members who wish to change or challenge the Club bylaws or SOPs, or other operational aspects including BOD decisions or actions. If the changes or challenges are not satisfactorily resolved by the BOD, the member may request a special meeting of the club. A method to call a special meeting of the entire club can be called where a 2/3 majority vote from those in attendance is needed to overturn BOD decisions. *Rational: The BOD must be responsive to the club members in addressing concerns and disagreements among member(s). Members need a method to request a special meeting of the general club membership.*
7. ARTICLE VIII, MEETINGS: Added additional means for Club Secretary to conduct BOD balloting of emerging issues by telephone or electronic means. *Rational: This expedites important decisions that do not require a BOD meeting. Facilitates decision making on items that do not require significant discussion.*
8. ARTICLE VIII, MEETINGS: Made the conduct of an annual meeting optional and including the option of communication of the meeting notice by USPS or electronic means. *Rational: Previous experience with health and availability requirements have resulted in the inability to conduct an in-person meeting. Supplemental means of election of board members and changes to bylaws and SOPs have been implemented.*
9. ARTICLE VIII, MEETINGS: Eliminate last two paragraphs describing special meetings. *Rational: Challenges to BOD actions including By-laws or SOPs are covered under Article VII, Club Rules. This includes disagreements or shortfalls with bylaws, SOPs, or other actions or decisions on how business is conducted.*
10. ARTICLE X, SUSPENSION OR EXPULSION: Clarified wording for replacement of a board member due to removal or resignation. *Rational: Self-explanatory.*
